

# Enchanted Forest set to compete for three awards

ONE OF Perthshire's top tourist attractions continues to go from strength to strength and has been short-listed for three Scottish Event awards.

The Enchanted Forest light and sound show in Pitlochry, which is organised by Perthshire Big Tree Country, will compete for the titles of Scotland's Best Cultural Event, Best Large Event and Best Event Marketing Strategy.

The winners will be announced at an awards ceremony to be held in Glasgow in September.

Chairman of The Enchanted Forest Stephen Bolland said, "This is excellent news and we are delighted to be shortlisted for so many categories—it's a real reflection of the quality of the event and its popularity with the Scottish public.
