

Your essential safety information

You are free to explore the sights and sounds of The Enchanted Forest in your own time and at your own pace. Please remember that The Enchanted Forest is an outdoor event and certain safety guidelines apply

Your visit to the forest

- Please keep to the official path at all times.
- The path includes some steep slopes and uneven surfaces. Please be careful.
- Do not touch the lights unless it is in a designated interactive area. Lights may be very hot.
- If a site steward asks you to do something, for your own safety, please comply with their request.

- No smoking or vaping allowed on site unless in designated areas. We request respectfully that you use these areas.
- No alcohol is permitted on site except for that sold on the night by our licensed caterers.

Your clothing

- Please wear warm, waterproof clothing.
- Please wear sturdy walking shoes or boots.

Your visibilty

- All designated pathways will be lit to ensure your safety
- Please bring a small torch for use in the unlikely event of a power failure.
- Only use your torch in an emergency as it may spoil the lighting effects.

 If you are using tripods or monopods please be aware these may not be visible to others.
Do not block footpaths.

Your children

 Children under 15 must be accompanied by an adult.

Your dogs

 Your assistance and emotional support dogs with the appropriate harnesses and paperwork are allowed at this event.

- If you've lost some of your personal property please notify a site steward at the entrance.

Travel information

Parking & shuttle buses

There is NO vehicle access to The Enchanted Forest. We have two departure points and your ticket includes a designated return shuttle bus from:

The Fishers Hotel at 75–79 Atholl Road, Pitlochry PH16 5BN.

If you have booked our Accessibility Bus, this departs from Blair Atholl Distillery, Pitlochry PH16 5LY.

Arrivals point

Your check-in time is not transferable. The time on your tickets is for the start of a 15-20 minute departure window, during which your tickets will be scanned, and you will be queued up, ready to board the bus as soon as it arrives. Please aim to get to departures for the time indicated on your ticket, not earlier. The queue will move very quickly with buses in constant rotation throughout the evening.

How to enjoy your visit

You are free to stay as long as you like to enjoy the show. a full circuit (1.8km) of the forest should take you around 60 minutes walking at a leisurely pace.

The return journey

Buses return to Pitlochry continuously throughout the night. The last bus will leave between 10.30pm and 11pm, depending on visitor numbers remaining on site.

Wheelchair parking passes

Due to limited space, disabled parking on site is reserved for wheelchair users only. If you would like to request a Wheelchair Parking Pass please book your tickets online and then contact SEE Tickets Customer Services with



your booking reference number to request a pass. A link to this service is available on our website. Please be aware that passes are allocated on a first come, first serve basis, and are subject to availability.

Cancellation policy

In the unlikely event of cancellation, an announcement will be posted on our website from 12 noon on the day of cancellation. All tickets are non-refundable and nontransferable except when cancellation is due to extreme weather conditions in Pitlochry only. Weather conditions in other places are not taken into consideration. An alternative date will be offered or your money refunded. If you are concerned about whether the show will proceed or not please check the website.
