ENCHANTING FOR OVER 20 YEARS

The Enchanted Forest is an award-winning sound and light show which transforms the beautiful Faskally Wood into a magical destination each October. One of the UK's most successful cultural events, attracting over 83,000 visitors annually, 2023 will celebrate the event's 21st birthday.

Having welcomed almost **718,000 visitors** since its inception in 2002, creating an estimated long term economic impact of around **£73 million** over its 21-year history, the unique nature of this show has gained it worldwide acclaim. It has grown from running for just over 3 nights in 2002, to now running over 33 nights to accommodate over **83,000** visitors annually. It has been a key driver in transforming a traditionally quiet time of the year into a significant period of tourism for businesses in Pitlochry and the Highland Perthshire region.

We're excited about this year's event, 'From the Deep', which will take place from 5 October until 5 November. This year's show will see visitors transported into the depths of an underwater world. Blending light, video, and sound to create a truly unique visitor experience. Faskally Wood will transform into an underwater forest with a deep-water glow of aqua blue and green. There may be some surprises along the way!

THANK YOU

We would like to say a big thank you to the community of Pitlochry and the wider Highland Perthshire region for graciously supporting The Enchanted Forest event faithfully every year. We know the numbers of visitors the event attracts comes with a level of disruption throughout the month of October, and we do appreciate your patience and hospitality. We know that, without your support, the show would not be the international success it is today. For our part, we will continue to listen to community concerns by attending community council meetings and doing our best to address these wherever possible.





This year we specifically sought applications that helped tackle poverty in the region and addressed cost of living challenges. CheckIN Works and Giraffe Trading is one of 17 charities awarded grant funding. The charity exists to improve accessibility to job opportunities for adults experiencing a diverse range of disabilities, mental ill-health, homelessness, and other barriers to sustaining meaningful employment.

The funding is being put towards **food**, **packaging**, and **prep costs** for the community kitchen the charity also runs, to support the trainees and wider community.

The Enchanted Forest Community Fund was set up in 2015 to redistribute proceeds from the event to the local community in Highland Perthshire and is administered by the Enchanted Forest Community Trust. Applications open in January every year.



PARKING MATTERS

Visitors staying in Pitlochry will be asked to leave their vehicle at their accommodation. If parking on the street, visitors are being asked in pre-show attendance information to park considerately, to observe any parking restrictions, and not to park on yellow lines. WHATTO EXPECT

The shuttle bus route to the forest and back will remain the same as in previous years and will begin at Fisher's Hotel in Pitlochry. Fisher's Hotel is a familiar start point for our many visitors and has the advantage of allowing other local businesses to benefit from passing trade.

The chosen bus route remains the safest option available, and parking restrictions will once again be implemented by **Perth and Kinross Council** to ensure minimal traffic disruption from visitors. It will also remove any obstacles so that the buses can freely travel to and from **Faskally Wood**. The parking restrictions include **West Moulin Road** and **Bonnethill Road** down to the

Scotland's Spa Hotel and will reduce any congestion and bus noise overall.

We will have a larger team of stewards this year, ensuring the smooth departure of buses throughout each night from Fisher's Hotel. We will be asking all visitors to arrive just before the start of their departure window detailed in their tickets, and not any earlier. We will also ensure they have their tickets ready to be scanned before boarding the buses. This should alleviate unnecessary congestion at the departure point.

BEING ACCESSIBLE

Making the Enchanted Forest event as accessible as possible has always been a priority. We want to make the event as accessible as we can, mindful of the restrictions we might have due to the natural forest setting, and that everyone's needs can vary. The paths of Faskally Wood are accessible for some wheelchair users, and we have a range of accessibility provisions in place which we've developed and enhanced over the years based on feedback, including our accessibility bus and the introduction of Autism friendly performances.



SUPPORTING LOCAL

One of our core values at the Trust is using local suppliers and businesses to support the event wherever possible. We're thrilled that two Perthshire based transport companies are providing the shuttle buses, and Highland Perthshire Shopmobility (based in Pitlochry) will again be providing wheelchairs for the event. Aberfeldy based Beyond Adventure is our first aid provider and an integral part of the team.

Ross Dempster, MD of Beyond Adventure, said: "Since 2017 Beyond Adventure has been part of the Enchanted Forest team, taking care of the first aid provision and water safety. We are delighted to be part of this fantastic local event again and look forward to welcoming visitors from all over the world."

The Enchanted Forest provides a significant boost for companies in Highland Perthshire and has transformed the fortunes of many hotels, restaurants, and cafes in the traditionally quieter shoulder month of October, to become one of their busiest periods of the year.

As a local charity, we want as many businesses as possible to benefit from the economic uplift the event brings every year. There are several ways we can help you reach our **83,000** visitors many of whom are looking for a place to stay, places to eat or things to do during the day.
